# UAOSU Officers Position Descriptions

- **President** (Article V, Section 1)  
Serves as executive officer, chairs the executive council, chairs membership meetings, and acts as chief spokesperson for the union
- **Executive Vice President** (Article V, Section 2)  
Oversees collective bargaining process, serves on several committees, and assumes president's duties in their absence
- **Secretary** (Article V, Section 3)  
Chairs the communications committee, records and maintains meeting minutes, and oversees union correspondence

# UAOSU Officer Position Descriptions

- **Treasurer (and Finance Committee Chair)** (Article V, Section 4)  
Keeps membership records, manages all financial transactions and records, and chairs finance committee
- **Grievance Committee Chair** (Article VII, Section 11)  
Chairs Grievance committee meetings, and oversees and coordinates all aspects of contract enforcement (with staff support)
- **Diversity and Equity Committee Chair** (Article VII, Section 5)  
Chairs D&E committee meetings and coordinates committee's work
- **Organizing and Membership Committee Chair** (Article VI, Section 12)  
Chairs O&M committee meetings and coordinates committee's work

# UAOSU Officer Position Descriptions

## **VP for TT Faculty Affairs** (Article V, Section 5a)

- Represents all tenure track members, other duties as assigned.
- Professor ranks

## **VP for NTTI Faculty Affairs** (Article V, Section 5b)

- Represents all non-tenure track members whose primary terms of employments are instruction-oriented, other duties as assigned
- Instructors, Professor (Clinical), Professor (Practice) ranks

# UAOSU Officer Position Descriptions

## **VP for NTTR Faculty Affairs** (Article V, Section 5c)

- Represents all non-tenure track members whose primary terms of employments are research-oriented, other duties as assigned
- Faculty Research Assistant, Research Associate, Postdoctoral, Professor (Senior Research) ranks

## **VPs for VP for Non-Corvallis Faculty** (Article V, Section 6)

- Represents members whose majority appoint is at a campus, facility, or office located off the main Corvallis campus, other duties as assigned
- Cascades, Hatfield, Portland, Extension county offices and research facilities, etc.

# UAOSU Representative Assembly

Legislative power and worksite representatives of our union

Duties include (Article IX):

- Hold regular meetings of membership of their College
- Recruit new members to our union
- Process grievances and resolve disputes in their College
- Serve as departmental/work site stewards
- Meets 6x a year to establish policies, review reports from Executive Council and committees
- Review & approve union budget
- Receive training related to steward and representative work
