- 11/12—Candidate statements (optional) due
- 11/13—Zoom information session #3—voting
- 11/16—Candidates announced and afterward ballots are mailed to members' homes
- 12/8—Balloting closes
- 12/11—Election results published

- UAOSU members in good standing can nominate other members for office and vote in the election.
