

- Consider each candidate on the ballot and mark all you approve of. Then place your ballot in the secrecy envelope provided, put it into the return envelope provided, and return it in the US mail.
- Ballots must be received by Tuesday, December 8th in order to be counted.

When will the votes be counted?

- The UAOSU election committee will count the ballots after December 8th, and publish the election results by December 11th.

What is 'approval voting'?

- Approval voting allows members to cast their votes for each candidate that they approve of to hold office. When ballots are tallied, the candidate with the greatest approval of their colleagues wins the seat.
- Candidates running unopposed must receive approval from at least 50% of the members voting to win their seat.
