- Vice President for Non-Tenure-Track Instructional Faculty Affairs
- Vice President for Faculty at Non-Corvallis Locations, Position #1
- Vice President for Faculty at Non-Corvallis Locations, Position #2

Representative Assembly (RA)

- Representative positions are based on College affiliation
- All RA positions that were not filled in the fall 2020 election will be up during this cycle
- Faculty not assigned to a College will be represented by the “at large” pool
