

Who can run for office?

- Faculty who joined our union on or before October 6th can seek nomination for officer positions.
- Representative Assembly nominees must be members in good standing by the close of nominations on February 18th.
- Any member can run for union-wide positions.
- To run for a constituency-specific position, the member must hold an appointment within that constituency.

How are candidates nominated?

- Nominees for officer positions must submit (or have submitted on their behalf) 20 member signatures, expressing support for their nomination. If you are seeking nomination for a constituency specific position, all signatures must be from members of that constituency.
- Nominees for Representative Assembly must submit 19 member signatures plus their own signature to represent their willingness to serve if elected. All signatures must come from members of that constituency.
- Due to concerns related to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Elections Committee will accept emails in lieu of physical signatures. The email template is available at uaosu.org/template.
- The nominee or their designee is responsible for submitting their petition (email) packet as one pdf document and sending it to elections@uaosu.org by 11:59pm on February 18th.
- The Elections Committee will verify all nominations and notify any nominees who failed to meet the criteria as soon as possible.
- Approved nominees for officer positions must confirm acceptance of their nomination in writing by 11:59pm on February 19th.
- The Elections Committee will publish the (certified) list of candidates on March 1st.

How will the election be conducted?

- Our election will be conducted via US mail. Ballots will be sent to your address on file on March 15th. If you need to update your contact information please email info@uaosu.org.
